



Keeping Our Facilities Safe

The following guidelines are meant to help protect the safety of all members and facility users, including children.

Guest passes are for our members' convenience. We encourage you to share the Y with your friends by bringing them with you. Below are some things you want to know about Guest Visits at our Y:

- **All guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.**
- Full Privilege Members, 18+, are issued four (4) complimentary guest passes per year.
- Guests, under the age of 18, MUST be accompanied by an adult.
- Guests are limited to general use of the facility.
- Adult basketball (RY facility) is restricted to Full Privilege Members only, at all times.
- Wellness Center use limited to guests 15 years and older.
- Child Watch is for Full Privilege Members only.
- Some other facility use restrictions may apply, please check with the branch you are visiting.
 - No guests Mon/Wed can use the RY branch after 6pm.
 - No guests during Open Swim times (all branches).

Proper Identification for Guests

All guests are required to show a valid, government-issued photo-ID (state ID/driver's license). All guests must complete and sign the liability waiver prior to their visit. Guests will also be registered in the membership software and have their picture taken and saved to their guest account.

Guest Pass Liability & Indemnity Waivers

All guests must complete a Guest Pass Liability Waiver (*found on our homepage of our website at www.cyedc.org*).

Guests, under the age of 18, must have a parent/legal guardian complete and sign the liability waiver prior to their visit.

Nationwide Reciprocity (Always Welcome in Every Community)

We want to encourage members to utilize the Y as often as they can. Sometimes, it's more convenient for members to utilize a Y in a different location when traveling, near a workplace or in another region. Now, Community YMCA of Eastern Delaware County members have the flexibility to use other Y facilities throughout the nation, at no extra charge. Simply present your active YMCA membership card and photo ID at one of the 2,000-plus participating YMCAs nationwide and enjoy free access.

RESTRICTIONS: All Community YMCA members visiting other participating YMCAs must abide by the individual YMCA's policies and procedures in regards to reciprocal access. All non-Community YMCA members who wish to access our facilities must present their YMCA membership card, along with a photo ID and abide by our policies and procedures in regards to reciprocal access. Your first visit to your non-home YMCA may require an intake process including: photo taken, ID check and national sex offender registry check. All YMCA members must use their home branch at least 50 percent of the time. Other restrictions may apply.
