- Good Academic Standing – submit a transcript indicating a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better.
- Good Character – a recommendation from a counselor, teacher, coach, or activity advisor indicating the applicant demonstrates the YMCA's core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility in his/her interactions with others.
- Positive YMCA Experience – a 250-300 word essay in which the applicant explains how the YMCA has positively affected his/her life.
