

CLEANING & SANITATION

The Y has in-stock the following EPA registered disinfectants for use at each of our locations.

- Lysol For Commercial Use. Aerosol disinfectant spray for high touch surfaces. EPA # 777-99-675
- Avistat-D RTU Spray disinfectant cleaner Manufactured by National Chemical Laboratories (NCL) EPA # 1839-83-2296.
- Defense Multi-Purpose, Broad Spectrum Cleaner Disinfectant with Bleach, RTU Manufactured by Spartan EPA # 5741-28.
- Pure Bright Germicidal Ultra Bleach EPA # 70271-13
- Virex II Manufactured by Diversity EPA Registration Number: 70627-24

All restrooms will be cleaned and all fixtures sprayed and wiped according to manufacturer's specification for disinfection. Common areas and high touch surfaces will be wiped every hour. Routine cleanings will be scheduled hourly. Nightly disinfection of our facilities will be applied via electro-static sprayers.

The ready-to-use products will be available for all staff to use. All areas of the YMCA will be supplied with hand sanitizer. In child care and summer day camp programs, only staff will be dispensing the hand sanitizer to children and only when hand washing stations are not available.
