Dear Families,

Thank you for a great first half of the school year, your continued support is amazing! Just a reminder, the first week of January is a virtual learning week. Both group A and B will be learning virtually at Scenic Hills. Please make sure your child brings all of their school books, computer, charger, and headphones. A reminder that we are no longer operating a carline for the YMCA. Please park your car and walk your child into the vestibule area to a YMCA staff member. Please take note that the health screening questions we ask at drop-off are always changing due to updated state restrictions.

If there is a change in your child's schedule and they will not be attending our program that day or heading home by bus or in the school carline, please inform a staff member through email, telephone, or during drop off/pick up times. If the YMCA is not aware of a change in schedule, the child will be brought to our program area and will follow normal pick-up procedures.

SPECIAL REMINDERS

Parents and family members are reminded of these important items:

- Continue to monitor your child's symptoms every morning
- If your child experiences any of the following symptoms in the chart below please keep them home and contact your pediatrician

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms	
Cough	Sore throat	Headache
Shortness of breath	Chills	Congestion or runny nose
Difficulty breathing	Muscle pain	Nausea or vomiting
Lack of smell or taste (without congestion)	Fatigue	Diarrhea

"COVID-19 Symptoms" is defined as having 1 or more symptom(s) in Group A
OR 2 or more symptoms in Group B

- Remember, that traveling out of state will require a 14-day quarantine prior to returning
- Continue to emphasize proper hygiene and handwashing/sanitizing
- Reinforce proper usage of face-coverings both inside and outside, throughout the entire school day.
