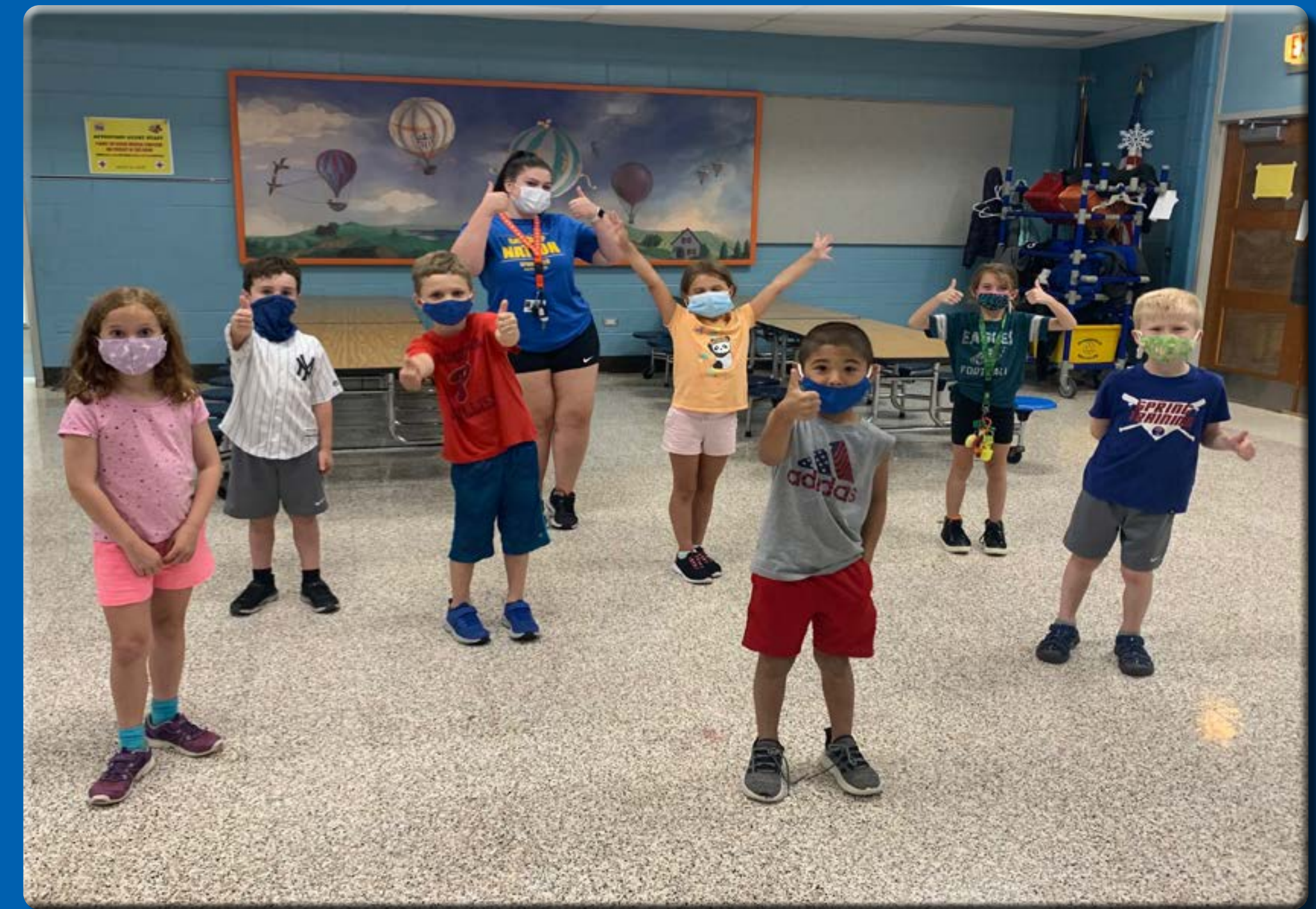
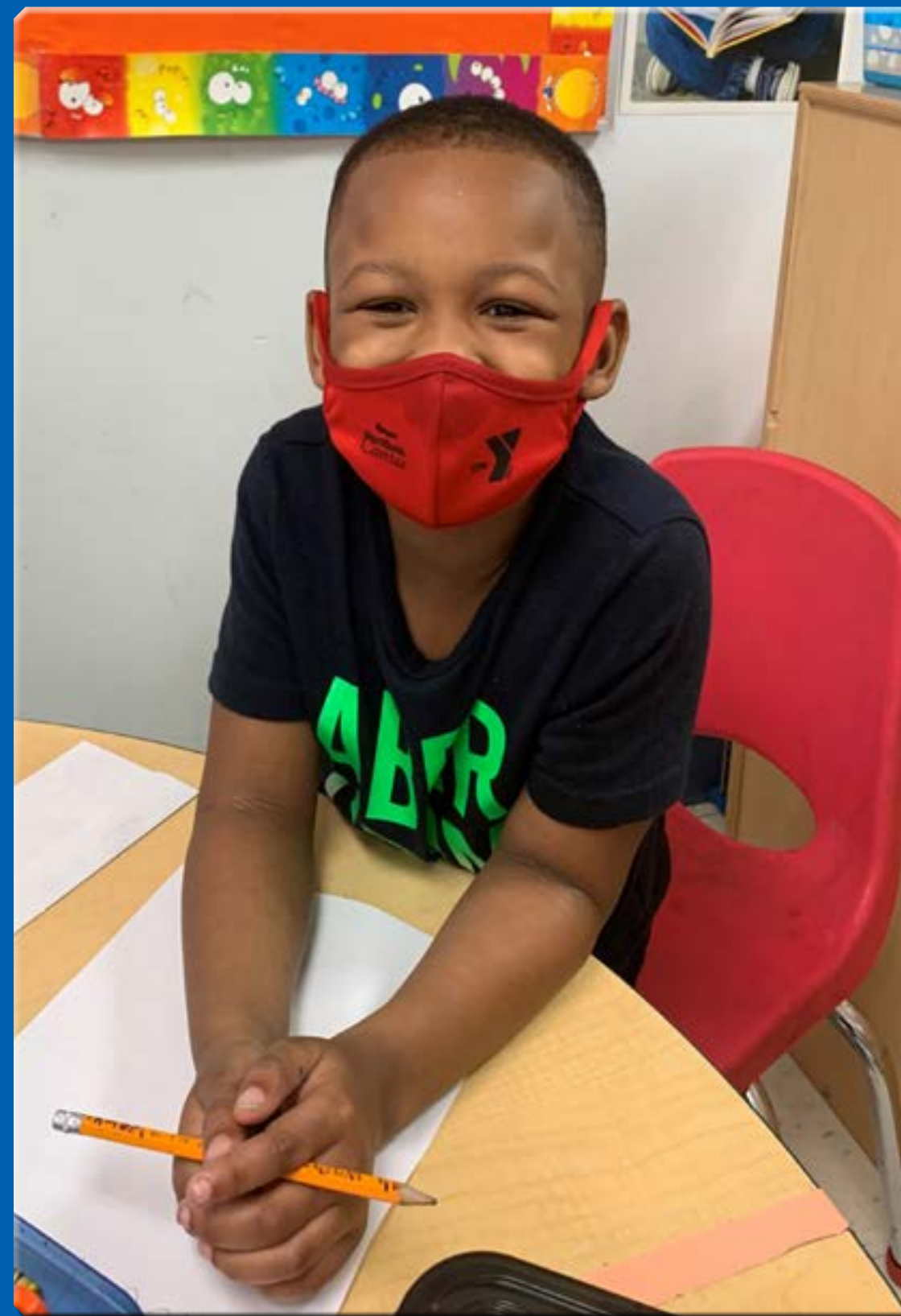
COMMUNITY YMCA OF EASTERN DELAWARE COUNTY
