## COVID Guidelines - MASK UPDATE

### Until further notice:

- All YMCA **staff are required** to wear masks while indoors regardless of vaccination status. Please note the following adjustments:
  - Masks may be removed when physically exercising/instructing or eating. When this occurs, please allow for six feet of safe social distance.
  - Masks may be removed when alone in a particular setting, for example an office, classroom, studio, etc.
  - Lifeguards may remove their masks when guarding from the guard stand, masks are required when walking on the pool deck.
  - Swim Instructors are to wear face shields vs. masks when instructing.
    - Only a mask will be accepted as a proper face covering. Gators are no longer permitted.

### Effective Tuesday September 7, 2021, and until further notice:

- All children, over the age of 2, enrolled in an early learning, school-age or ChildWatch program will be required to wear a mask at all times while indoors.
  - Only a mask will be accepted as a proper face covering. Gators are no longer permitted.
  - Medical exemptions to masking guidelines must be endorsed by a licensed physician and submitted to the YMCA.
  - Masks are mandated by federal law while on all public transportation including YMCA buses and vans. All staff and students are required to wear a mask to and from school.

- **All members are required to wear a mask while walking around the Y. Masks may be removed when physically exercising.**
  - All members entering/exiting the Springfield branch are required wear a mask while walking in the hospital hallways. This is a requirement of the hospital as our landlord.

Please remember:

- If you or a member of your household are feeling unwell, please remain home.
- Immediately contact the YMCA if you believe you or a member of your household has been exposed to COVID-19.
- Continue practicing six feet of safe social distancing.
- Practice good hygiene by frequently washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Be mindful of your actions while away from the Y.

We know that not everyone will have the same perspective. As a **community impact organization**, however, we are trying to do what is best for our community. Your support and positive approach to these safety measures is what will make the difference.
